**Luján Has Missed 1.6% Of Roll Call Votes.** “From Jan 2009 to Feb 2015, Luján missed 72 of 4,564 roll call votes, which is 1.6%. This is better than the median of 2.2% among the lifetime records of representatives currently serving. The chart below reports missed votes over time.” [GovTrack, accessed [2/27/15](#)]
